



If 4 Kids or WorkLink should need to close...

In the event that the 4 Kids Early Learning Network or the WorkLink Community Van Service should need to suspend operations—for example, because of severe weather—parents and riders can get up-to-the-minute information from these sources.

- Three TV stations—KDKA, WTAE, and WPXI—will be notified, so the information will be displayed on-air along with other school and organizational closings.
- Within four hours of the emergency, we will post information on the home page of our website, at www.HeritageCommunityInitiatives.org.
- Within four hours of the emergency, we will have a recording on our main telephone number, at 412-351-0535.
- We have purchased an automatic alert system. If we have a current telephone number for you, we will either call or text you.
